By taking place in Spain, the Husqvarna Trek 2024 offers everyone who attends an incredible riding experience thanks to the special location. In addition to three full days of discovering the hidden treasures of Granada on two wheels, on hand throughout the trip will be a knowledgeable support crew to make sure your time at the Husqvarna Trek 2024 is one to remember.

Husqvarna Trek 2024 is the perfect event for riders who enjoy long days of adventure-style riding. Each day will offer a unique experience and a variety of different terrain, including desert as well as plenty of winding gravel roads through the mountains of Andalusia. Along the way, those who like to challenge themselves can try more technical alternative lines to test their skills before re-joining the main route.

There really is no better way to discover the hidden treasures of Granada than by riding your Husqvarna machine through the rugged wilderness, especially as most of the stunning viewpoints are only accessible by motorcycle. Pre-planned routes with local experts

Self-navigation with GPS or our GPX-files

This way you can follow your timing and enjoy it at your level and speed.

Lead riders and sweep riders

You just get on your bike each morning and ride without worries the whole day.

Luggage support

Our luggage van transports your items each day, leaving you with a light load to enjoy the adventure.

Technical support

Peace of mind knowing our team is on hand at each home base to assist with any minor mechanical issues that may arise.

Medical support

With medical support following, ride at ease knowing that you will have assistance should you need it.

Backup vehicle and sweep support

Following all riders each day will be a 4WD with trailer, as well as sweep riders ready to help, have a chat or ride along with.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day

During a long day of riding, don't worry about where to find your meals, meaning you can relax and relive the day with a group of like-minded friends.

Trek facts



Dates:

Monday, 18th of November – Friday, 22nd of November 2024

Destinations:

Monday, 18th – Day 1

Welcome and registration in the historic city of Granada at the foot of the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Tuesday, 19th – Day 2

Riding from Granada to Guadix exploring the Gorafe Desert.

Wednesday, 20th – Day 3

Riding through the Tabernas Desert and hidden routes to Baza before spending the night glamping under the stars.

Thursday, 21st – Day 4

Exploring twisty highland tracks before heading back to Granada through spectacular canyon scenery.

Friday, 22nd – Day 5

Individual departure.

What is included:

- Three full days of riding
- Self navigation with GPS using GPX files provided to all participants
- Lead riders and sweep riders
- Luggage, technical and medical support
- Backup vehicle and sweep support
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day
- Shared accomodation organised and included for the whole expedition period

Trek Fee: 1.990,- EUR per rider

- Husqvarna 701 Enduro, 701 Enduro LR, Norden 901, or Norden 901 Expedition
- Registered motorcycle
- Third-party property damage insurance or comprehensive motorcycle insurance (recommended)
- Offroad tyres
- It is recommended to have offroad motorcycling experience

Route and navigation

Granada City, capital of Andalusia's Granada province, is the fitting host for the start and finish of the Husqvarna Trek 2024!

From Granada, the Trek will head through the forests to reach the Gorafe Desert – Andalusia's own Grand Canyon – for the first overnight in the region's famous cave houses. The next day will see the Trek pass through the Tabernas Desert, climbing high into the hills of Sierra Alhamilla with ocean and desert views, before heading to Baza and ending in a remote glamping spot under the Andalusian sky. The last day will explore the region's highlands before returning to Granada on a spectacular, fun route.

The Gorafe region's desert terrain will offer riders flowing forest tracks and fire trails, climbing from the Gorafe Desert to the edge of epic escarpments, with stunning views back over the desert from numerous lookout points along the way. Riders will enjoy plenty of elevation changes throughout each day – but the steeper uphill and downhill sections will be kept for the hard routes!

Further highlights of the route include water crossings, followed by long, flowing sections.

The main route will offer easier tracks for riders, however the hard routes will feature more overgrown and challenging sections, where sometimes only single bikes can pass.

Our local route coordinators have the key objective of providing riders with a near all-dirt

experience, with most days featuring 80% offroad and very limited asphalt sections between overnight destinations and fuel and lunch stops.

The Husqvarna Trek will be suitable for a wide range of riders. Therefore, two route options will be offered throughout the event. The main route will be achievable for those in their first few years of adventure riding (we strongly advise that riders should have at least two years of offroad riding experience). The daily hard route options will offer challenges to those looking to push their limits and broaden their horizons.

Lead riders will depart ahead of the group every morning to ensure the tracks are clear and sweep riders will bring up the tail end of the pack to assist with any issues that may arise throughout the day.

Choose daily which routes you wish to take – this adventure is designed for every rider to make their own. Each day's route can be traversed in your own time, at your own pace. To facilitate this, navigation for riders will be via GPS, with arrows to assist throughout the day and route sheets supplied at each night's rider briefing. It is mandatory for all riders to have a GPS unit or GPS navigation capabilities for the Husqvarna Trek. The route sheets will also feature Points of Interest to take note of each day.

Trek support

To assist riders in making the most of their Husqvarna Trek experience, we offer the following support.

Luggage support

An allocation of one bag per rider is available in the luggage van, which will be carried between each overnight destination. This bag can be either a roll-bag or pack (no hard luggage).

Technical support

We will have a team available to assist with any minor issues that may arise along the way that you cannot fix yourself.

Genuine parts support

All riders are advised to bring along spare parts. However, in case of unforeseen circumstances that may arise when adventure riding, we will have a range of genuine parts available to purchase throughout the Husqvarna Trek.

Medical support

We will have medical support staff available to assist with rider injuries.

More information on the provided support will be given in the Registered Rider Pack to those who register for the event.

Accommodation and dinners



For the Husqvarna Trek, riders do not need to book any hotel. The Husqvarna team will take care of the accommodation.

Once registered, all riders will receive a **Registered Riders Pack** outlining all of the accommodation locations, and where nightly rider briefings and dinners will be held, which we call the “home base”.

Home base

Each night we will have a home base where all support will be available, including luggage, technical and medical. These will also be the most likely dinner destinations for the night, as well as the venues for rider briefings and nightly social revelry.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner

These are included in the Husqvarna Trek every day. From the welcome dinner on the first night to the final wrap-up dinner.
